Where: Albury Manor House Motel, 593 Young St, Albury N.S.W. Australia 2640.

Accommodation: book your own directly with the motel. They say they will match any price found online and that by booking with them directly you can make sure you get the inclusions or room type you require.

Programme: when finalised will be sent to all those attending.

Other Events: if there is enough interest on the Thursday we will be able to organise a tour of some local wineries or attractions.

Meals: there will be a banquet on Wednesday evening that is costed separately to the conference itself. It will be a three-course meal with a medieval flavour. Drinks will be served separately and can be booked to your room account. We will also have the chance to have a meal together on Tuesday night for those arriving that day. This will be in the motel bistro and at your own cost. There will also be an option for an afternoon tea on arrival on Tuesday afternoon. It is Melbourne Cup day so proper to be a little festive.

Travel: The Albury Airport is situated quite close to town. Car parking is available at the motel.

Train: Kevin Herbert has kindly put together the following information about travelling by train from Sydney to Albury and is co-ordinating some joint travel. There is a 7.32a.m train from Central to Albury on Tuesday 1st November, returning 11.49a.m from Albury to Central on the Thursday 4 November. Currently the system won't allow bookings for 1st November and beyond until Thursday 5th May though the booking clerk to whom Kevin was speaking suggested that it might be wiser to wait to book until the Friday 6th May. Please note for pensioners travelling 1st Class (viz Car C) there is an added cost of \$21.27 each way.

Car C is recommended though it is a bit more expensive as it has many advantages. It has a large accessible toilet at the entrance to the carriage, is quite spacious, has a maximum of only 23 passengers and is adjacent to the buffet. It is also likely to have a largish number of Ricardians booked on these days. Always recommended as excellent travelling companions.

There is a local taxi service to take you from the station to the motel that is only a short drive away. Fellow Ricardians with cars will also be available for pickups. Please let us know if you would like to be picked up.
